



PAID INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Would you like to gain valuable job experience in your field?

In cooperation with the Greening Youth Foundation (GYF), Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site has an internship position available starting May 24th 2010 to August 14th 2010. Students will work a total of 520 hours over the course of the summer and use the experience for internship credit and job experience. You will be paid a weekly stipend of \$220.

Area Description:

Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site is located 2 miles East of Downtown Atlanta, Georgia in the Old Fourth Ward Historic District.

Work Description:

Duties include:

- 1) Researching, preparing, and conducting youth educational programs "*King for Kids: Live Like a King*" and public talks and tours.
- 2) Operating visitor centers.
- 3) Providing park and area information in response to visitor inquiries in person or over the telephone.
- 4) Compiling visitation statistics; and assisting with special events.
- 5) NPS will provide classroom and on-the-job training in: park orientation, The National Park Service, Interpretation, CPR with AED, and First Aid.

Positions involve public contact, ability to communicate orally in front of groups, flexibility, being a team player, writing skills, quality time management skills, working in humid environments, and rendering first aid if necessary. Educate the public on historical and cultural resources preservation. Uniform provided.

FREE housing maybe available in the Birth Home Preservation District.

Qualifications:

- Completed two years of undergraduate coursework or sophomore level.
- Academic backgrounds in history, education, teaching, public relations, tourism, government, international studies, broadcasting, sociology, journalism, English, or related fields.
- Communication skills.
- Writing skills
- Valid driver's license.
- Personal transportation.
- Ability to work with the public.
- Ability to work as a team.
